

TUESDAY LADIES EVENING LEAGUE RULES - 2023

1. Play may be done anytime on Tuesday, but evening play is encouraged. You must always play with another member of the league for your score to count for the weekly event or flag prize. Tee times may be made 1 week prior to play.
2. Put \$1 in the slot designated for our league and sign the roster that will be located by the slot for the \$1. This money will be used to pay-out the prize money for that week for the event. Prize money will be paid out at the end-of-the-year dinner for the season.
3. The "Red" tees will be used. Players 60 and over may choose to play from the "Gold" tees. Players must choose either the "Red" or "Gold" and not play from both tees.
4. Play ball up anywhere (including bunkers). You may move your ball 1 scorecard length and in unmaintained bunkers you can rake and replace ball where it was.
5. Record your putts for each hole.
6. Maximum of 10 strokes per hole, if you have reached 10 strokes, pick-up your ball and putt your ball from the furthest spot of another player in your group is putting from to count your putts.
NOTE: for the league championship rounds, you must record your full score if higher than a 10.
7. If you lose a ball don't spend more than a couple of minutes looking for it. Record a 2-stroke penalty and place your ball in the middle of the fairway as close to where you think it was lost/out of bounds.
For Example: if you lost your ball on your drive, place the ball in the middle of fairway where lost and you will be hitting your 4th shot. This is to maintain pace of play instead of going back to where you previously hit your ball.
8. If your ball goes in the water on holes 4, 12, 15 or 17, please add an additional stroke and hit again. If your next shot goes in the water, please pick up your ball and carry your ball to the other side of the water and count an extra stroke.
For example, if you hit your ball in the water on 12 on your 2nd shot, hit another ball, that ball will be counted as your 4th shot. If that shot goes in the water, carry your ball across the water and play another ball, you will be hitting your 6th shot. There is NOT an extra stroke for the carry.
9. At the end of the round, sign your scorecard for the group and put in the slot that you paid your \$1 in. The events coordinator will collect the scorecards and send out an email to let everyone know who the winners are for that week. Record your score in the Central Links website and it will calculate your handicap. Please make sure to do this so your handicap can remain accurate.
10. The events coordinator will also keep track of any pars, birdies and chip-ins that you record each week. You will receive money back at the end-of-the-year for each one that you record, but only once per hole.
11. Keep pace with the group in front of you. If you are a slow group, please let the group behind you play thru.
12. Bunker Play or Under Construction: if the course is cart path only for the round, you may remove your ball from a bunker and place behind the bunker to take your next shot without taking a penalty stroke. If ground is under repair, place ball behind repair and hit your next shot without a penalty stroke.
13. Gimmie Putts will be given if within a foot. This gimmie putt does count as a stroke.
14. **Be courteous and respectful to ALL players (men or women) and ALL staff members at ALL times.** Follow golf etiquette and if you don't know...ask! If you have an issue please report it to the pro shop or a league officer for resolution.
